

ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY IN THE SPANISH AIR FORCE

The Ministry of Defence, through Directive No. 107/1997 "On the Protection of the Environment within the Scope of the Department", has expressed a desire to reconcile the missions of the Armed Forces with an Environmental Policy based on the *sustainable development* concept, keeping at all times its operational capability that enables to fulfil the missions assigned by the current legislation. The aforementioned Directive is developed by Instruction 56/2011 from SEDEF. Apart from this, in the field of the Air Force, General Instruction 90-31 defines the organization, management and responsibilities of the Environmental Management System.

As a consequence of the above, from this date the Spanish Air Force will implement for all its dependencies a common Environmental Management System which will apply only the **Environmental Policy** principles listed below:

- 1. To seek the continuous improvement of the Environmental Management System and to protect the environment in its facilities and locations, avoiding its aggression and disturbance.
- 2. To comply with the applicable legal requirements and internal environmental regulations of the Ministry of Defence.
- 3. To plan its activities with a view to minimizing negative environmental impact.
- 4. To promote Energy Efficiency measures by using, whenever possible, renewable energies.
- 5. To promote measures that allow saving in the consumption of natural resources and to make, in all cases, rational use of them.
- 6. To ensure proper management of waste, discharges and emissions generated.
- 7. To protect and improve, as far as possible, natural spaces within its locations.
- 8. To improve environmental awareness and culture by ensuring the necessary environmental training.
- 9. To strengthen institutional relations to enable a better environmental performance.
- 10. To disseminate this Environmental Policy within the scope of its responsibility.
